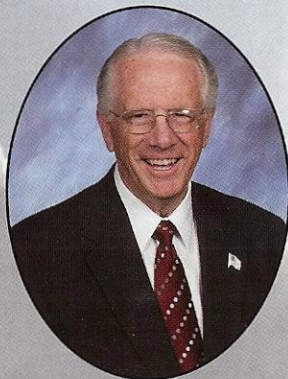


Ministers

Pulpit Minister
