# *SAUL SEES JESUS*

- **Acts 9:3—“And it came about that as he journeyed, he was approaching Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him.”**
- **Acts 26:13— “at midday, O King, I saw on the way a light from heaven, brighter than the sun.”**
- **Acts 22:11—“. . . I could not see because of the brightness of that light.”**

# ***SAUL HEARS JESUS***

- **26:14—“And when we had all fallen to the ground, I heard a voice saying to me in the Hebrew dialect, ‘Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.’”**
- **9:5a; 22:8a; 26:15a—“And he said, ‘Who are You, Lord?’”**
- **22:8b—“And He said to me, ‘I am Jesus the Nazarene, whom you are persecuting.’”**

# *SAUL'S QUESTION*

**Acts 22:10a**

- **“What shall I do, Lord?”**

# *SAUL RECEIVES HIS COMMISSION*

- **22:10b—“Arise and go on into Damascus; and there you will be told of all that has been appointed for you to do.”**
- **9;6—“Rise and enter the city, and it shall be told you what you must do.”**

# *SAUL RECEIVES HIS COMMISSION*

- **26:16-18—“But arise, and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you; delivering you from the Jewish people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, in order that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.”**

# *SAUL GOES INTO DAMASCUS*

- **22:11–“But since I could not see because of the brightness of that light, I was led by the hand by those who were with me, and came into Damascus.”**
- **9:11-12– The Lord appeared to Ananias and told him to “go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for a man from Tarsus named Saul, for he is praying, and he has seen in a vision a man named Ananias come in and lay his hands on him, so that he might regain his sight.”**

# *COMMISSION REAFFIRMED*

- **9:17—“Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road by which you were coming, has sent me so that you may regain your sight, and be filled with the Holy Spirit.”**
- **Acts 22:13b—“Brother Saul, receive your sight!”**
- **Acts 9:18a—“And immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he regained his sight.”**
- **Acts 22:14-15—“And he said, 'The God of our fathers has appointed you to know His will, and to see the Righteous One, and to hear an utterance from His mouth. 'For you will be a witness for Him to all men of what you have seen and heard.'”**



# *SAUL RECEIVES HIS ANSWER*

- **Acts 22:16—“And now why do you delay? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on His name.”**

# *SAUL OBEYS*

**Acts 9:18**

**“ . . . and he got up and was  
baptized.”**
