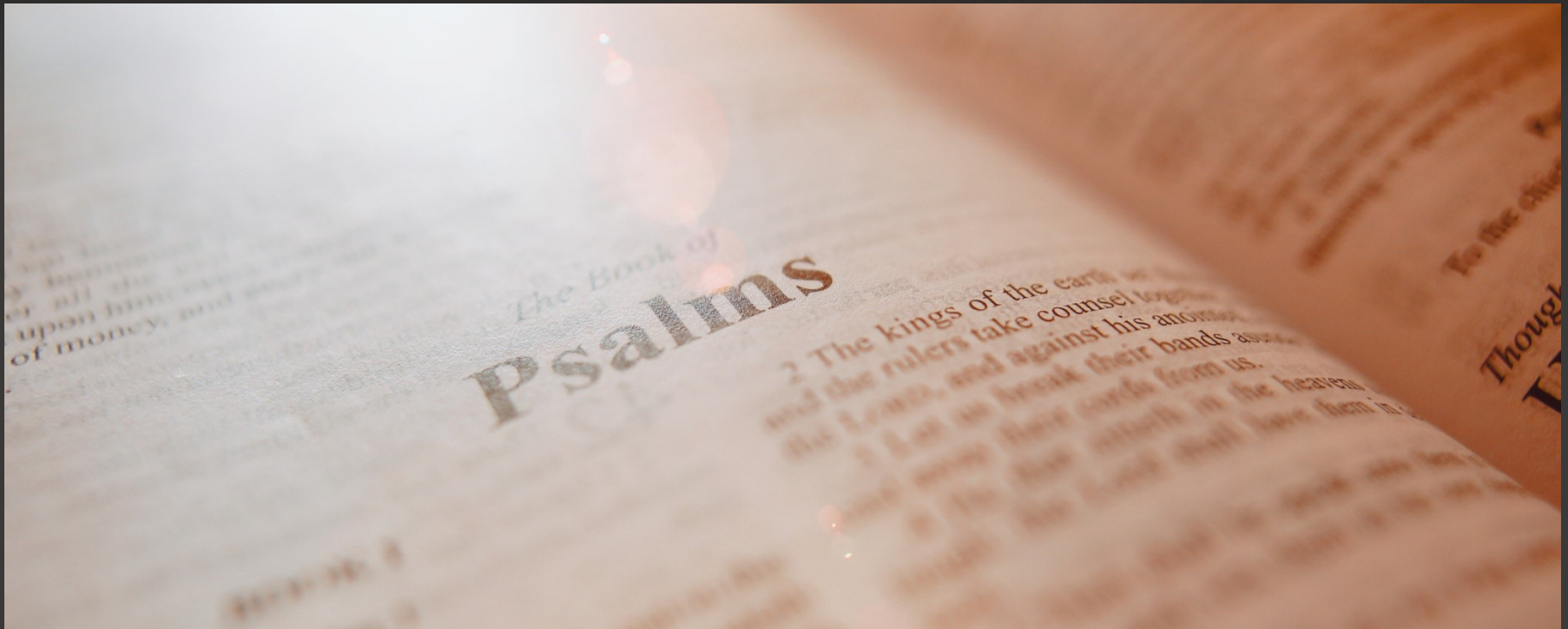

ever.

<sup>2</sup> Every day I will bless You,  
And I will praise Your name forever and  
ever.

<sup>3</sup> Great is the LORD, and highly to be  
praised,  
And His greatness is unsearchable.

2) We praise God from one generation to another.

# Psalm 145:4-7

<sup>4</sup> One generation shall praise Your works to another,  
And shall declare Your mighty acts.

<sup>5</sup> On the glorious splendor of Your majesty  
And on Your wonderful works, I will meditate.

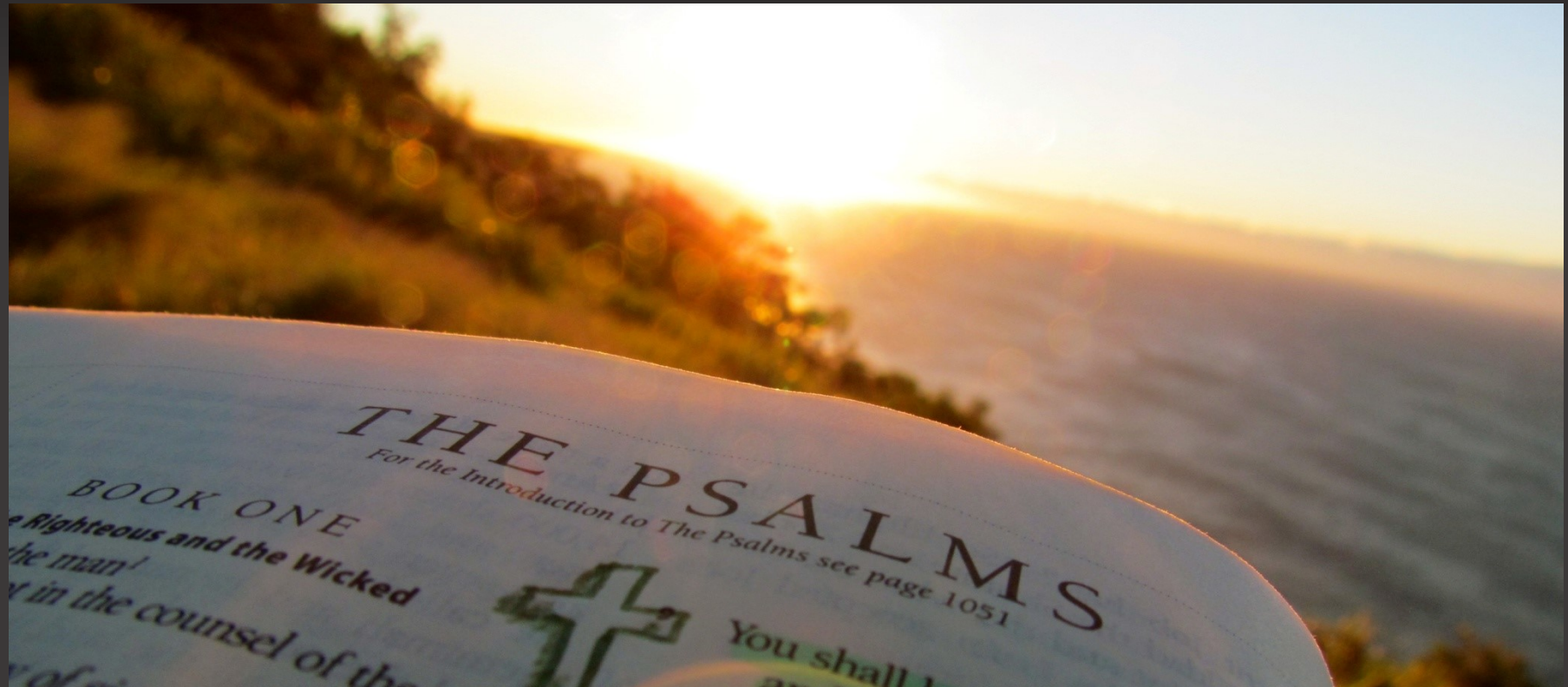
# Psalm 145:4-7

# Some Thoughts from Psalm 145



3) Notice in the psalm: we sing praise “about” God, and we also sing praise “to” God.

And His mercies are over all His works.

# Psalm 145:6-7

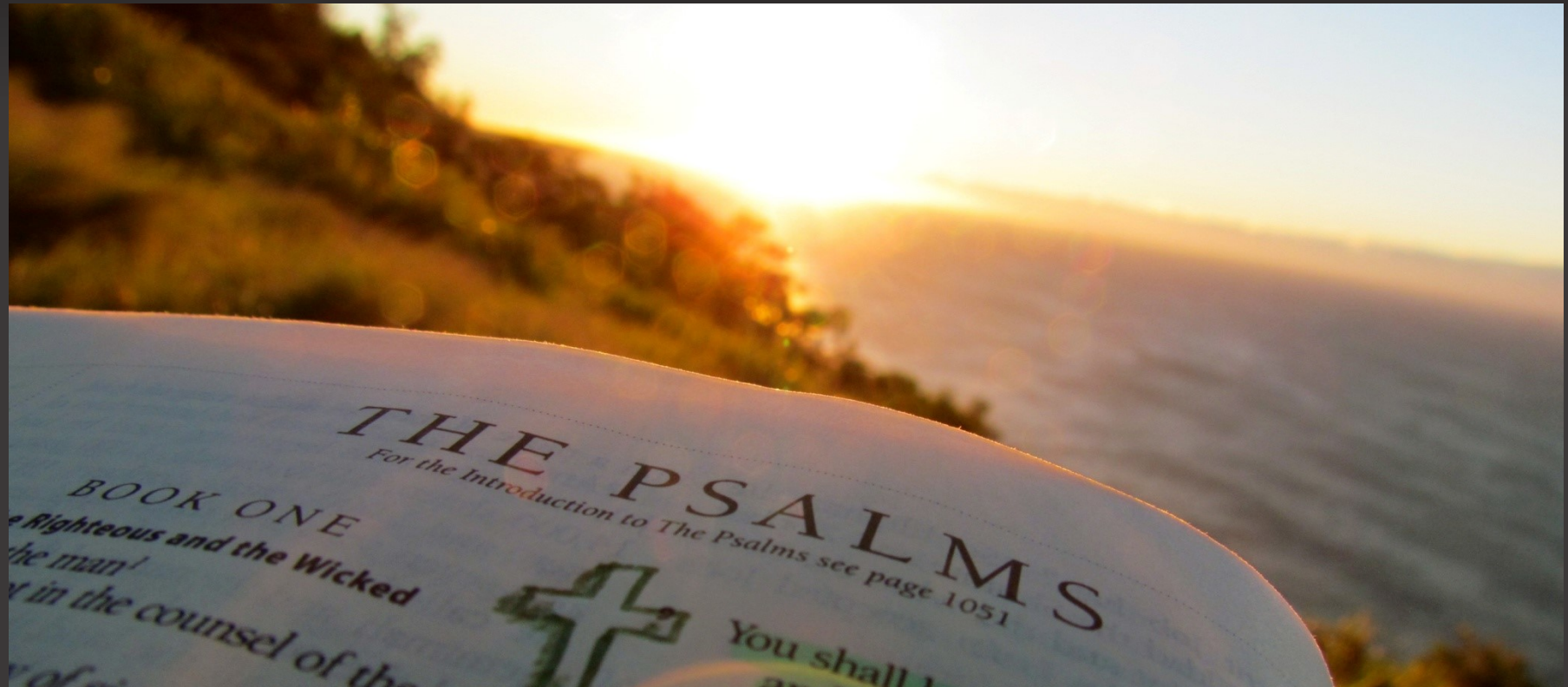
<sup>6</sup> Men shall speak of the power of Your awesome acts,
