²⁶ What is *the outcome* then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

Foundational Biblical Worship Principles, #3

3) Yet it must not be so formal that it lacks meaning –

we appropriately engage in the emotions of worship.

The five acts we find God wants in the New Testament:

Preaching/Scripture

Prayer

Singing

Lord's Supper

Giving

Worship in Song

¹⁶ Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

What is *the outcome* then? I will pray with the spirit and I will pray with the mind also; I will <u>sing</u> with the <u>spirit</u> and I will <u>sing</u> with the <u>mind</u> also.



Giving God the right <u>act</u>: <u>singing</u> only, like the apostles taught.

Ephesians 5:19

¹⁹ speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;



Giving God the right <u>spirit</u>:

an engaged <u>heart</u>,

one that desires to <u>live</u> <u>out</u> the songs.




Let's spend some time in true worship as we sing together...
