# John 13:1-5

<sup>1</sup> Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

# John 13:1-5

<sup>2</sup> During supper, the devil having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, *the son* of Simon, to betray Him,



# John 13:1-5

<sup>3</sup> *Jesus*, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God and was going back to God,

# John 13:1-5

<sup>4</sup> got up from supper, and laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself.



# John 13:1-5

<sup>5</sup> Then He poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

# John 13:6-9

<sup>6</sup> So He came to Simon Peter. He said to Him, “Lord, do You wash my feet?”

# John 13:5-9

<sup>7</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, “What I do you do not realize now, but you will understand hereafter.”

<sup>8</sup> Peter said to Him, “Never shall You wash my feet!” Jesus answered him, “If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.”

# John 13:5-9

<sup>9</sup> Simon Peter said to Him, “Lord, *then wash* not only my feet, but also my hands and my head.”



# Philippians 2:7

...Christ Jesus,  
<sup>6</sup> who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,  
<sup>7</sup> but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.

➤ Jesus is God,  
yet He comes to  
serve us.





This Act Challenges  
Jesus' Followers





➤ Luke 22:24-27 shows they needed this.

## Luke 22:24-27

<sup>24</sup> And there arose also a dispute among them *as to* which one of them was regarded to be greatest.

<sup>25</sup> And He said to them, “The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them; and those who have authority over them are called ‘Benefactors.’

## Luke 22:24-27

<sup>26</sup> But *it is* not this way with you, but the one who is the greatest among you must become like the youngest, and the leader like the servant.

<sup>27</sup> For who is greater, the one who reclines *at the table* or the one who serves? Is it not the one who reclines *at the table*? But I am among you as the one who serves.





➤ We are supposed to live like Jesus.

# John 13:12-17

<sup>12</sup> So when He had washed their feet, and taken His garments and reclined *at the table* again, He said to them, “Do you know what I have done to you?”

<sup>13</sup> You call Me Teacher and Lord; and you are right, for so I am.

# John 13:12-17

<sup>14</sup> If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

<sup>15</sup> For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you.

# John 13:12-17

<sup>16</sup> Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master, nor *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him.

<sup>17</sup> If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them.





➤ Some verses to notice:

# Matthew 23:11-12

<sup>11</sup> But the greatest among you shall be your servant.

<sup>12</sup> Whoever exalts himself shall be humbled; and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted.

# Matthew 20:25-28

<sup>25</sup> But Jesus called them to Himself and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and *their* great men exercise authority over them.

# Matthew 20:25-28

<sup>26</sup> It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant,  
<sup>27</sup> and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave;



# Matthew 20:25-28

<sup>28</sup> just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”

# John 13:31-35

<sup>31</sup> Therefore when he had gone out, Jesus said, “Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him;

<sup>32</sup> if God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately.

# John 13:31-35

<sup>33</sup> Little children, I am with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, now I also say to you, 'Where I am going, you cannot come.'



# John 13:31-35

<sup>34</sup> A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

<sup>35</sup> By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”




The world should see Jesus'
