Foundational Biblical Worship Principles, #5

A passage that shows another reason God may not accept worship:

¹ "Beware of practicing your righteousness before men to be noticed by them; otherwise you have no reward with your Father who is in heaven.

² "So when you give to the poor, do not sound a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, so that they may be honored by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full.

- ³ But when you give to the poor, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing,
- ⁴ so that your giving will be in secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you.

⁵ "When you pray, you are not to be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that they may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full.

Prayer


Singing

Giving can be done as a kindness or it may also be a religious practice, or it may also be done as worship.







- ⁶ Now this *I say*, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.






Matthew 28:19-20
