➤ Our passage for this morning:

John 15:1-11

- ¹ "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.
- ² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.
- ³ You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

The Vine and the Branches



The word used repeatedly: "Abide"

- ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can* you unless you abide in Me.
- ⁵ I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

- ⁶ If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned.
- ⁷ If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

- ⁸ My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and *so* prove to be My disciples.
- ⁹ Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love.

- ¹⁰ If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.
- ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full.

The Vine and the Branches



➤ One thing to notice: this passage shows it is possible to stop <u>living</u> for Christ and forfeit your <u>salvation</u>.

² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.

⁶ If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned.

Matthew 7:21

²¹ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter.

2 Peter 2:20

²⁰ For if, after they have escaped the defilements of the world by the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and are overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first.

¹⁵ No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you.

4) Promises about <u>prayer</u>

⁷ If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

1 Peter 3:12

12 "FOR THE EYES OF THE LORD ARE TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS,
AND HIS EARS ATTEND TO THEIR PRAYER,
BUT THE FACE OF THE LORD IS AGAINST THOSE
WHO DO EVIL."

5) <u>Joy</u>

¹¹ These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full.
