





A Place to Find Strength

And yet we find that prayer has even more <u>blessings</u>, in addition to what we ask for...







We don't know what Paul's "thorn" was, but it was from <u>Satan</u>, and in some way it made him <u>weaker</u>.






Learning from Paul's Struggles






