






How Do I Pray?

Luke 11:1

¹ It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John also taught his disciples."

The Wrong Way to Pray



We don't pray just to be seen.

Matthew 6:5-6

⁵ "When you pray, you are not to be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that they may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full.

Matthew 6:5-6

⁶ But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door and pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you.

Matthew 6:7-8

- ⁷ "And when you are praying, do not use meaningless repetition as the Gentiles do, for they suppose that they will be heard for their many words.
- ⁸ So do not be like them; for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

What Should I Say to God?

Matthew 6:9-13

⁹ "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

Matthew 6:9-13

- ¹¹ 'Give us this day our daily bread.
- ¹² 'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
- ¹³ 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.']



What Should I Say to God?

A - Adoration

Matthew 6:9

⁹ "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.



What Should I Say to God?

C - Confession

Luke 18:13-14

¹³ But the tax collector, standing some distance away, was even unwilling to lift up his eyes to heaven, but was beating his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, the sinner!'

Luke 18:13-14

¹⁴I tell you, this man went to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who humbles himself will be exalted."



What Should I Say to God?

T - Thanksgiving

Psalm 100:4-5

⁴ Enter His gates with thanksgiving And His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him, bless His name.

⁵ For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting And His faithfulness to all generations.



What Should I Say to God?

S – Supplication (Requests)

Philippians 4:6

⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

"In Jesus' Name, Amen?"

- ²⁴ Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be made full.


"In Jesus' Name, Amen?"



Amen means "let it be so."


1 Corinthians 14:16
