
¹⁰ So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

1) We are tempted to criticize.

Galatians 5:25-26

¹⁶ Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.


1 Thessalonians 4:18
