








1) Passage to Notice: Ezekiel 22:29-30


Ezekiel 22:29-30

Ezekiel 22:29-30


³⁰ I searched for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand in the gap before Me for the land, so that I would not destroy it; but I found no one.

2) Passage to Notice:

Luke 11:5-10


- ⁵ Then He said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend, and goes to him at midnight and says to him, 'Friend, lend me three loaves;
- ⁶ for a friend of mine has come to me from a journey, and I have nothing to set before him';

⁷ and from inside he answers and says, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been shut and my children and I are in bed; I cannot get up and give you *anything*.'

⁸I tell you, even though he will not get up and give him *anything* because he is his friend, yet because of his <u>persistence</u> he will get up and give him as much as he needs.


- ⁹ "So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.
- ¹⁰ For everyone who asks, receives; and he who seeks, finds; and to him who knocks, it will be opened.

3) Passage to Notice: Isaiah 37

of Judah, 'Do not let your God in whom you trust deceive you, saying, "Jerusalem will not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria."

- ¹⁴ Then Hezekiah took the letter from the hand of the messengers and read it, and he went up to the house of the LORD and spread it out before the LORD.
- ¹⁵ Hezekiah prayed to the LORD saying,

• • •

Now, O LORD our God, deliver us from his hand that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You alone, LORD, are God."

²¹ Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent word to Hezekiah, saying, "Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, 'Because you have prayed to Me about Sennacherib king of Assyria, ²² this is the word that the LORD has spoken against him: ...

³⁵ 'For I will defend this city to save it for My own sake and for My servant David's sake.'"

- Then the angel of the LORD went out and struck 185,000 in the camp of the Assyrians; and when men arose early in the morning, behold, all of these were dead.
- ³⁷ So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed and returned *home* and lived at Nineveh.

We won't know until <u>eternity</u> all the ways prayer made a difference.


Quietly Changing the World
