but the one that is most emphasized in Scripture: <u>salvation</u> of humanity.

Matthew 1:21

²¹ She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

Matthew 20:28

²⁸ just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and <u>to give</u> His life a ransom for many."

John 14:6

⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Listening to Jesus: What Must We Do?

1) Jesus taught that we must believe in Him to be saved.

John 3:16

¹⁶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever <u>believes</u> in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 8:24

²⁴ Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you <u>believe</u> that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

Listening to Jesus: What Must We Do?

2) Jesus taught that we must repent to be saved.

Luke 13:1-5

¹ Now on the same occasion there were some present who reported to Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices.

Luke 13:1-5

- ² And Jesus said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were *greater* sinners than all *other* Galileans because they suffered this *fate*?
- ³ I tell you, no, but unless you <u>repent</u>, you will all likewise perish.

Luke 13:1-5

- ⁴Or do you suppose that those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them were worse culprits than all the men who live in Jerusalem?
- ⁵ I tell you, no, but unless you <u>repent</u>, you will all likewise perish."

Listening to Jesus: What Must We Do?

3) Jesus taught that we must be baptized to be saved.

Matthew 3:13-17

- ¹³ Then Jesus arrived from Galilee at the Jordan *coming* to John, to be baptized by him.
- ¹⁴ But John tried to prevent Him, saying, "I have need to be baptized by You, and do You come to me?"

Matthew 3:13-17

¹⁵ But Jesus answering said to him, "Permit *it* at this time; for in this way it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then he permitted Him.

Matthew 3:13-17

- ¹⁶ After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove and lighting on Him,
- ¹⁷ and behold, a voice out of the heavens said, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased."

John 3:1-5

- ¹ Now there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews;
- ² this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God *as* a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

John 3:1-5

³ Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

John 3:1-5

⁴ Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" ⁵ Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 4:1-2

- ¹Therefore when the Lord knew that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John
- ² (although Jesus Himself was not baptizing, but His disciples were),

Matthew 28:18-20

¹⁸ And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

Matthew 28:18-20


- ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, <u>baptizing</u> them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,
- ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Listening to Jesus: What Must We Do?

4) Jesus taught that we must continue following Him to be saved.

John 8:31-32

³¹ So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; ³² and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."





Acts 2:37-38

- Now when they heard this, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?"
- ³⁸ Peter *said* to them, "<u>Repent</u>, and each of you be <u>baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

James 5:16

¹⁶ Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and <u>pray for one another</u> so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.
