

### Matthew 28:19-20


- <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,


### Acts 11:19-20

- <sup>21</sup> And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a large number who believed turned to the Lord.


### Acts 11:22-24



# Compassion


#### Acts 11:27-30


