Learning From Jesus




Jesus' <u>life</u> is an amazing example of prayer.





⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. ...


Psalm 63:1-3

- 46 and said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray that you may not enter into temptation."


Luke 22:43




