# Reflecting on Suffering

#### We will face suffering in our broken world.

### Job 14:1

<sup>1</sup> "Man, who is born of woman, Is short-lived and full of turmoil.

\*All Scriptures from 1995 New American Standard Bible

# 1 Peter 4:12

<sup>12</sup> Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you;

# Reflecting on Suffering

It's helpful to think through suffering from a "<u>head</u>" perspective and from a "<u>heart</u>" perspective.

### What Our Heart Needs to Hear

#### In the midst of suffering:

### 1) God <u>hurts</u> with us.

# Romans 8:26

<sup>26</sup> In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but <u>the Spirit</u> <u>Himself intercedes for *us* with</u> <u>groanings too deep for words</u>;

# Romans 8:17

<sup>17</sup> and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed <u>we suffer with *Him*</u> so that we may also be glorified with *Him*.

#### In the midst of suffering:

### 2) God listens and comforts.

# Romans 8:26-27

- <sup>26</sup> In the same way <u>the Spirit also helps</u> <u>our weakness</u>; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words;
- <sup>27</sup> and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because <u>He intercedes for the saints</u> according to *the will of* God.

# Romans 8:35-39

- <sup>35</sup> <u>Who will separate us from the love</u> <u>of Christ</u>? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- <sup>36</sup> Just as it is written,
- "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG;
- WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED."

# Romans 8:35-39

<sup>37</sup> But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him <u>who loved us</u>.

# Romans 8:35-39

- <sup>38</sup> For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers,
- <sup>39</sup> nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from <u>the love of God</u>, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

# Psalm 34:18

<sup>18</sup> The LORD is near to the brokenhearted And saves those who are crushed in spirit.

#### In the midst of suffering:

3) God <u>promises</u> that evil will be <u>judged</u>.

# Romans 8:37

<sup>37</sup> But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.

# Romans 8:19-22

- <sup>19</sup> For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God.
- <sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope

# Romans 8:19-22

- <sup>21</sup> that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.
- <sup>22</sup> For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now.

#### In the midst of suffering:

### 4) God gives us <u>strength</u> to <u>endure</u>.

### Romans 8:31

<sup>31</sup> What then shall we say to these things? If God *is* for us, who *is* against us?

# Romans 8:37

<sup>37</sup> But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.

# Philippians 4:13

<sup>13</sup> I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.

# 2 Timothy 4:16-17

- <sup>16</sup> At my first defense no one supported me, but all deserted me; may it not be counted against them.
- <sup>17</sup> But the Lord stood with me and strengthened me, ...
- and I was rescued out of the lion's mouth.

#### In the midst of suffering:

# 5) God works to bring good.

## Romans 8:28

<sup>28</sup> And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.

# Genesis 50:20

<sup>20</sup> As for you, <u>you meant evil against</u> <u>me, but God meant it for good in order</u> to bring about this present result, to preserve many people alive.

#### In the midst of suffering:

6) God promises a better <u>home</u> where it will all be <u>worth</u> it.

# Romans 8:18

<sup>18</sup> For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

# 2 Corinthians 5:8

<sup>8</sup> we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at <u>home</u> with the Lord. In a world of suffering, may we <u>cling</u> to God, who deeply <u>loves</u> us.

# Acts 2:37-38

- <sup>37</sup> Now when they heard *this*, they were <u>pierced to the heart</u>, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?"
- <sup>38</sup> Peter *said* to them, "<u>Repent</u>, and each of you <u>be baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

# James 5:16

<sup>16</sup> Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and <u>pray for one another</u> so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.
