
# The Psalms and My Love for God



### Keeping First Things First



➤ A passage that helps center our faith: Mark 12:28-34

<sup>28</sup> One of the scribes came and heard them arguing, and recognizing that He had answered them well, asked Him, "What commandment is the foremost of all?"

- <sup>29</sup> Jesus answered, "The foremost is, 'HEAR, O ISRAEL! THE LORD OUR GOD IS ONE LORD;
- <sup>30</sup> AND YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH.'

The second is this, 'You shall love Your Neighbor as Yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

- The scribe said to Him, "Right, Teacher; You have truly stated that HE IS ONE, AND THERE IS NO ONE ELSE BESIDES HIM;
- AND TO LOVE HIM WITH ALL THE HEART AND WITH ALL THE UNDERSTANDING AND WITH ALL THE STRENGTH, AND TO LOVE ONE'S NEIGHBOR AS HIMSELF, is much more than all burnt offerings and sacrifices."

Matthew's account says everything else "hangs" from those two.







- <sup>2</sup> Thus I have seen You in the sanctuary, To see Your power and Your glory.


## Psalms 63:1-5



- When shall I come and appear before God?


## Psalms 18:1-3

## Psalms 30:1-5


<sup>5</sup> For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for a lifetime; Weeping may last for the night, But a shout of joy *comes* in the morning.
