
Where Do We Go When We Die?

²⁶ For just as the body without *the* spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead.



Revelation 20:13


¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds.

Luke 23:43


⁴³ And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise."

2 Peter 2:4


⁴ For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell [Tartarus] and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;

2) If we are alive when He comes, our bodies will be changed.


1 Corinthians 15:51-53

3) Final judgment before God.

Matthew 25:31-32



⁴⁶ These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."


Matthew 8:11-12
